Many of the children have lost one or both parents to AIDS and other poverty-related diseases, and all of them are victims of extreme social and economic deprivation. Their charitable concerts around the world help to raise both funds for and public awareness of the African Children's Choir schools, which have been set up to educationally support and encourage the children and their families in these countries.
