6 pm service in the Well: Andy Murray will be speaking about "Safe families for children"

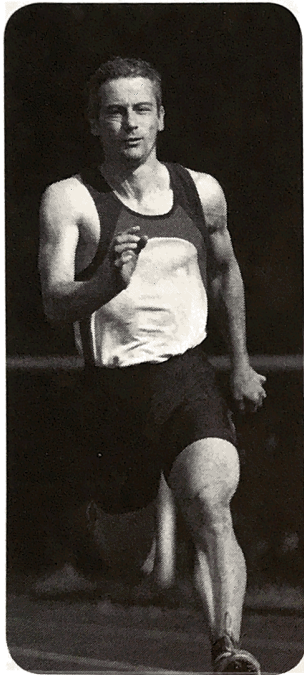
1. You are warmly invited to join the **pre-service prayer group** in the Smith cafe from 10.15 am onwards on Sunday mornings.

Check it out for yourself

- 1** Read Luke 2:1-7. Explain how Christ's birth was part of his humiliation.
- 2** Read Galatians 4:4-5; Luke 2:27-28; and Matthew 5:18. What do you think it meant for Jesus to live under the Old Testament law?
- 3** Read Philippians 2:3-8. What was the attitude of Christ in these verses? What should your attitude be?
- 4** Read Isaiah 53:1-12. This Old Testament prophecy indicated several ways in which the Lord would be humiliated. State what they are.
- 5** Read Luke 22:39-46. According to these verses, why was Jesus in anguish?
- 6** Read Acts 2:22-28, 31-32. What did God the Father do for his Son? Was Christ's body subject to any form of decay?
- 7** Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-4. Which message is of primary importance in the Bible?

Memorize the following catechism answer and Bible memory verse:

Catechism Question

'What did Christ's humiliation consist of?'

Answer

'Christ's humiliation consisted of his being born, and that under humble circumstances, under the Old Testament law; his experiencing the miseries of this life, the wrath of God, the curse of death on the cross, burial and the power of death for a time.'

Memory Verse

'And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross' (Philippians 2:8).
