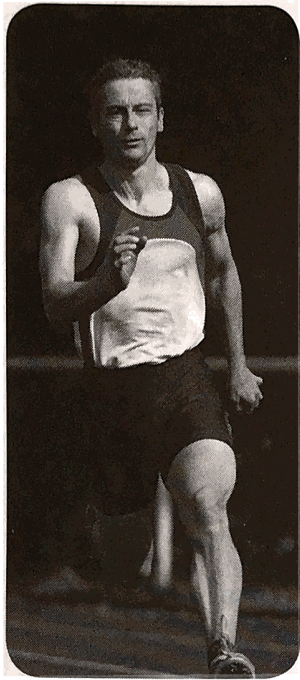
1. You are warmly invited to join the **pre-service prayer group** in the Smith cafe from 10.15 am onwards on Sunday mornings.

Catechism Question

'How does Christ fulfil the office of a priest?'

Answer

'Christ fulfils the office of a priest by offering himself once as a sacrifice to satisfy the Father's righteous anger against sin, thereby reconciling us to God, and interceding for us now.'

Memory Verse

'For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens'
(Hebrews 7:26).
