Day of prayer

It compares favourably with last year but bear in mind the following points. We have not had to pay rent since April this year, we have no second salary for our youth worker, and we await an invoice from Edinburgh relating to administrative charges. Of the income, some £11,000 came from tax reclaims for gift aided giving. By signing this declaration the church will get an extra 25p for every £1 you give.
